Blue Home with UNC Health Alliance gives you access to:

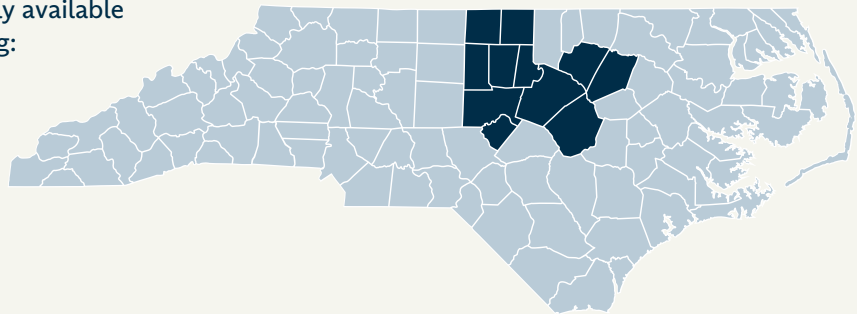
- UNC Health's network of hospitals and providers, including more than 1,900 primary care providers²

- Some of these out-of-network providers include: Cone Health, Duke Health, and WakeMed
- Out-of-network coverage is not included, except for emergency and urgent care services which will be covered at the in-network benefit level⁵

Out-of-network urgent care and emergency services are covered at the same cost share level as in-network urgent care and emergency services.

6 Prescription drug deductible must be met before your plan begins to pay for prescriptions except when indicated otherwise.

7 PCP step down benefits: 3 x \$0 copay for PCP office visits, followed by standard PCP copay (at the member level).

8 Prescription drug costs are subject to the medical deductible, coinsurance, and out-of-pocket limit.

9 Prescription drug costs are not subject to the deductible.
